

Our Curriculum

At The Victory Academy we aim to give our students a challenging, rewarding and diverse curriculum that develops cultural capital translating into strong outcomes for all pupils, regardless of their starting points.

Through these curriculum principles we aim to instil three core Victory Values in our students:

- Pride in self, others, and their community
- Respect for self and others
- Belief in self and others.

Our curriculum and values are embedded in all aspects of school life, enabling our students to develop into aspirational young adults. This prepares students for the next steps in their life journey by developing long term knowledge and skills which can be effectively deployed in new circumstances.

Providing academic challenge

Our curriculum promotes opportunities for depth of academic enquiry as well as providing a broad and balanced learning experience The curriculum is coherently planned and sequenced to ensure that both knowledge and skills develop and, subsequently, understanding deepens. 
